



PROCEDURES AND GUIDELINES CONCESSIONS

1. By Athens-Clarke County ordinance, the Morton Theatre is a **smoke-free environment**.
2. Food and drink sales require rental of the historic E.D. Harris Pharmacy (see rate schedule).
3. Food and drink that contain any artificial red or blue dyes are not permitted. The presenter must police this or an extra cleaning charge (see contract) will apply.
4. No food or drink is permitted in the auditorium.
5. Food and drink are ONLY permitted in the Pharmacy and in the lower lobby. The presenter must police this or an extra cleaning charge (see contract) will apply.
6. Presenter agrees to provide proof of appropriate license and comprehensive general liability insurance (see requirement in the rental contract) within 7 days prior to first performance date, or upon request.
7. Recycle bins are provided in the pharmacy for cans, bottles, and #1 and #2 plastic containers and table ware. Please encourage patrons to utilize them. Paper recycling is also available. See Morton staff on duty for paper receptacles.
8. If you choose not to offer concessions, the Morton Theatre Corporation reserves the right to operate the E.D. Harris Pharmacy space for concessions. Morton Theatre Corporation retains 100% of the revenues derived from the sale of their concessions.
9. Cancellations of pharmacy use require 2 business days notice to avoid being charged the rental and/or custodial costs.
